After meeting the couple through mutual friends, we were asked to transform their formerly dark, paneled living room into a bright, vibrant living space. It was given a second lease on life with custom cerused oak millwork and a silvery metallic Phillip Jeffries wallcovering. Sleek, custom-designed furnishings create an intimate yet airy conversation space anchored by a refurbished marble fireplace restored to its former glory.

Overall design concept or goal:

The living room was previously covered in dark wood paneling, and heavy window treatments overpowered the space and obstructed the influx of natural light. Oversize furniture hindered the natural flow throughout the room, and, due to its central location, the neglected fireplace was in desperate need of a facelift. By removing the paneling, adding a silvery-toned wallpaper, and updating the millwork, we revitalized the room and created the illusion of more space and higher ceilings. Incorporating clean-lined, appropriately-sized pieces gave the space a brand new look and feel, and the restored fireplace now functions as the show-stopping centerpiece it was always meant to be.
